### 2022 FESTIVAL PLANNED FOR NOVEMBER 9-17, 2022

NEW YORK, November 29, 2021 – DOC NYC, America's largest documentary festival, wrapped its 12th annual edition on Sunday, November 28, 2021. Following an entirely online version last year, the 2021 festival returned to theaters in New York City, while continuing to screen films online for audiences across the U.S. The program, running 19 days, offered more than 250 documentary features and shorts, including 32 world premieres and 34 U.S. premieres, and drew more than 25,000 viewers for in-theater and virtual screenings. The in-person portion of the festival included hundreds of in-person filmmaker Q&As and eight days of panels for documentary creators and industry presented in the DOC NYC PRO conference. Additionally, festivalgoers watched more than one million minutes of films online.

"It was enormously gratifying to offer incredible documentaries to our audiences both in person and online this year," said DOC NYC Executive Director Raphaela Neihausen. "We were thrilled to bring filmmakers and moviegoers together in theaters again, and also to be able to present our lineup to documentary lovers across the country."

Special guests who appeared in person at this year's DOC NYC festival included musician Kenny G, NBA hall-of-famer Kevin Garnett, pop icon Dionne Warwick, actress Selma Blair, Nobel prize-winner Dmitry Muratov, musician and filmmaker Ahmir "Questlove" Thompson, actress and activist Ricki Lake, composer and musician Jon Batiste, actor Fred Armisen, actress and filmmaker Sonja Sohn, photographer Steve McCurry, record-setting mountain climber Nirmal "Nims" Purja, and record executive Clive Davis, along with dozens of other festival filmmakers.

The festival also announced that the 13th edition of DOC NYC will take place November 9-17, 2021.
